

Documentation Centre - Consultation and Research

The documentation centre makes its archive and library available to both amateur and professional researchers. Please note the following conditions:

1. Every researcher must formulate a solid research question.
2. The curator and collection manager of Sportimonium asbl decide whether the research question is sufficiently substantiated.
3. Restrictions may be imposed on the documents to be consulted. These restrictions may relate to:
 - The fragility of the pieces;
 - The number of documents requested per consultation;
 - The size;
 - Other factors.
4. Documents from the documentation centre and books from the library may be consulted in the reading room.
5. The visitor only has access to the reading room and not to the archives or library itself.
6. The documents are laid out in the reading room.
7. The curator and collection manager may have certain requirements for a piece to be consulted. This may include wearing gloves, a dust mask or a restriction to only look at a piece.
8. The making of copies or photos must be requested in advance.
9. Sportimonium asbl provides visitors with protective equipment.
10. Food and drinks are not allowed within the reading room.
11. Sportimonium asbl does not offer any drinks or food.
12. The researcher undertakes to provide Sportimonium asbl with a copy of the publication resulting from this research.

The documentation centre (archive and library) is open on Mondays and Thursdays from 10 a.m. until 3 p.m. Appointments must always be made in advance.
